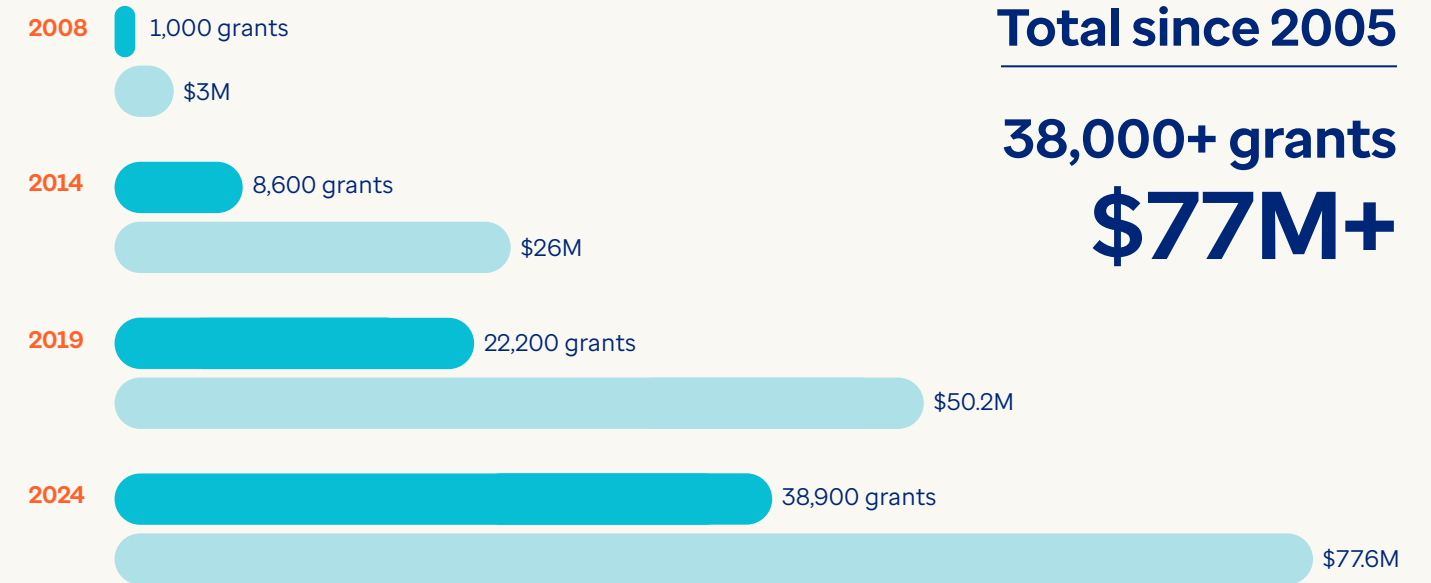

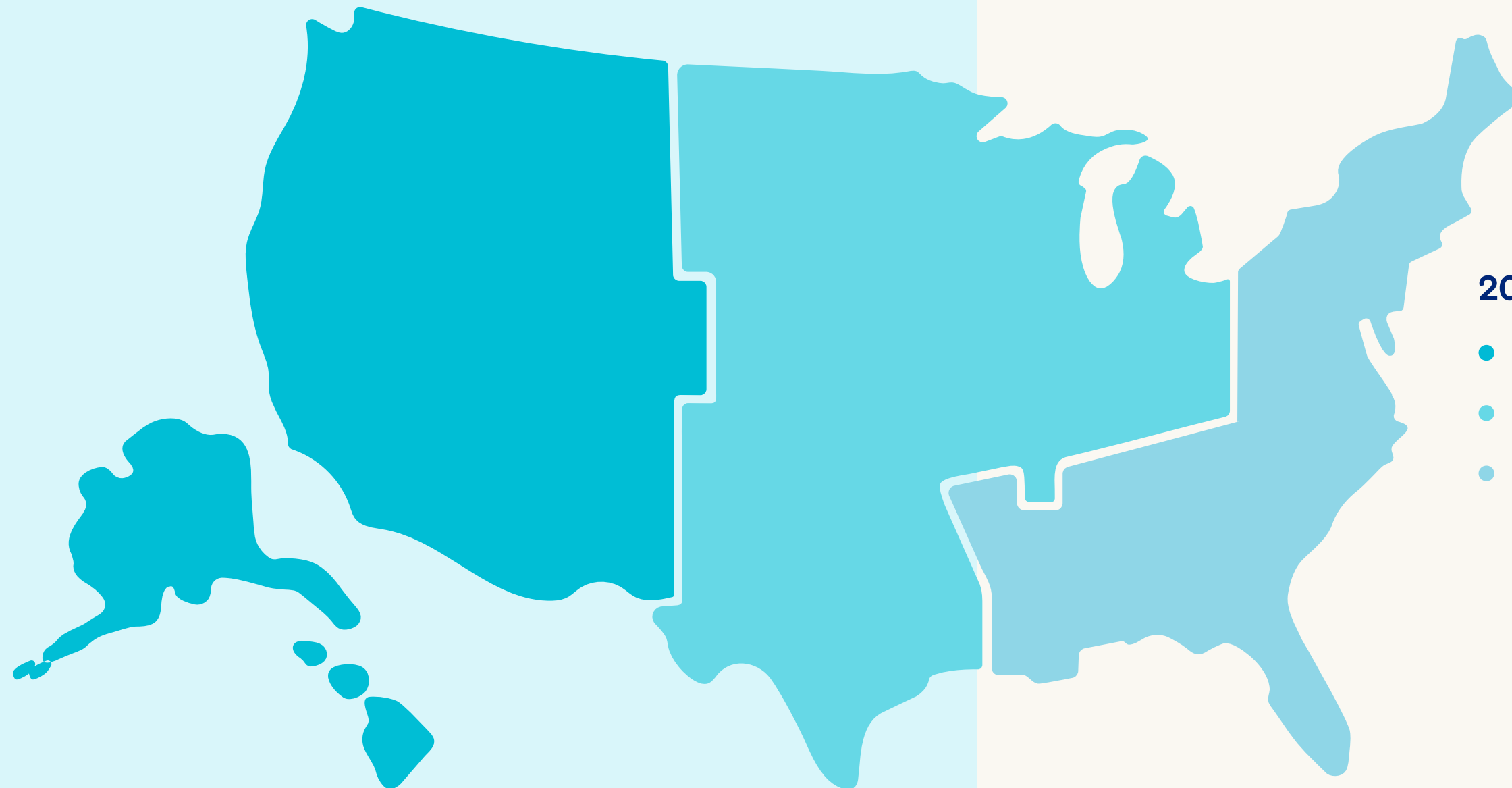

Where are they now?

Bailey, 10

Ever wonder how the kids and grant families we support are doing? We have an update on Bailey and her family from Vancouver, Washington.

Bailey, now 10 years old, has anaphylaxis and severe food allergies. Bailey and her family attended our Velo and Vines event in 2023. We learned so much about Bailey and her food allergies. She showed us how to use her EpiPen, explained she can only eat food that is either made at home or prepared specifically for her, and told us all about the Tolerance Induction Program she is a part of to try to reach food freedom. Bailey and her sister Sami Su stole all our hearts, and spending time with her inspiring family was fantastic.

Bailey has been awarded 6 grants totaling the lifetime maximum of \$10,000. She attends the Southern California Food Allergy Institute. The program desensitizes a child to the foods that cause allergic reactions, introducing them through a specialized program for each child.

“Bailey has passed everything in the Tolerance Induction Program, and she is on the lowest plan for peanuts because her allergy is so severe. They continue to work hard daily and hope her body will accept peanuts soon.” —Bailey’s mom, Amanda

The family is extremely grateful for the medical grants they have received from UHCCF, which have genuinely enhanced Bailey’s quality of life.

Century Ride

More than 100 cyclists gathered in July for the 13th annual Century Ride, which raised over \$720,000 to fund 450 medical grants. Riders chose their own adventure with the option to select a 100-mile, 62-mile, or e-bike route through the rolling hills of the Twin Cities.

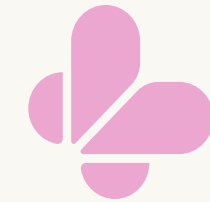

Hero Days

Programs that change lives

Grins to Go

Throughout 2024, we hosted 20 Grins to Go events for teams and individuals to get their grin on, including teams from across the entire enterprise. With this program, one child receives a great boredom-busting gift bag filled with books, games and puzzles, while another receives a UHCCF medical grant. Thanks to everyone who participated in Grins to Go activities, we assembled more than 1,000 activity bags that went to children in hospitals, foster care centers and support services. These events raised over \$64,000, which funded more than 40 medical grants for kids.



Hope's Heroes

In 2024, employees and supporters put forth their creative best to back UHCCF. Teams from across the organization, including Optum HouseCalls, UnitedHealthcare provider operations and UHCCF ambassadors, held walks, photo contests and gift basket giveaways to raise funds for UHCCF. These events brought virtual teams together across the country and raised more than \$19,000, which funded 12 medical grants for kids.



Cuddles to Go

We hosted 40 Cuddles to Go events for teams and individuals throughout 2024. Thanks to everyone who participated in Cuddles to Go activities, we tied more than 850 blankets that provide the gift of comfort for children in hospitals, foster homes and more. And, in addition to the blankets, these fun and unique events raised over \$22,000, which funded 14 medical grants for kids.



Grins²

With the Grins² shopping program, your gift will go twice as far. When you purchase a gift from our Simply Do Goods online store, a child at one of our participating children's hospitals will receive your gift while another child receives a UHCCF medical grant. From joke books to plush toys, you can give one smile and get two in return. In 2024, 2,867 items were shipped out to 211 children's hospitals across all 50 states. Thanks to the over 2,700 individuals who donated items to make children's holidays a little brighter!



Teddy Bear Run

Over 1,900 participants and 200 teams laced up their sneakers and hit running trails across the country for the 3rd annual Teddy Bear Run as part of a movement to help kids and change lives. Runners and walkers virtually logged miles throughout the month of October and raised over \$172,000, which helped fund more than 90 medical grants for children.

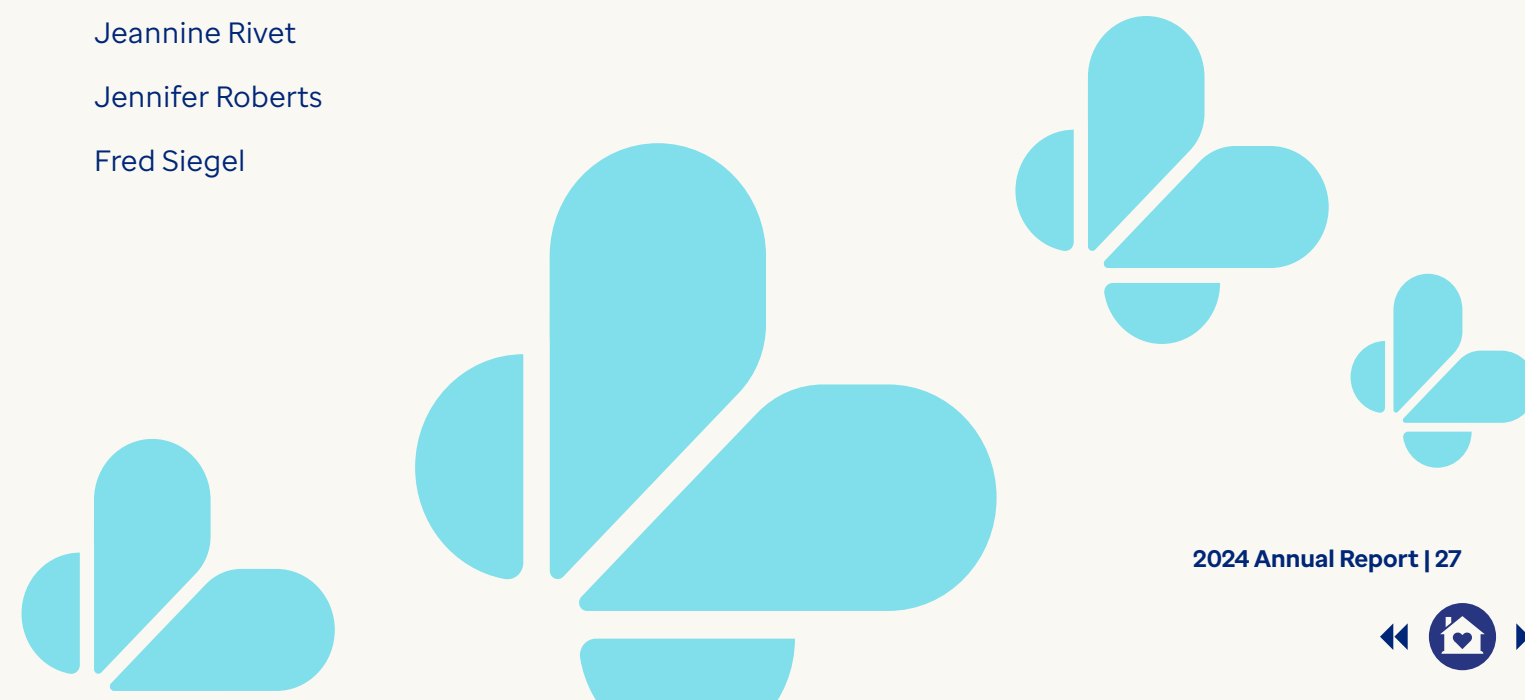

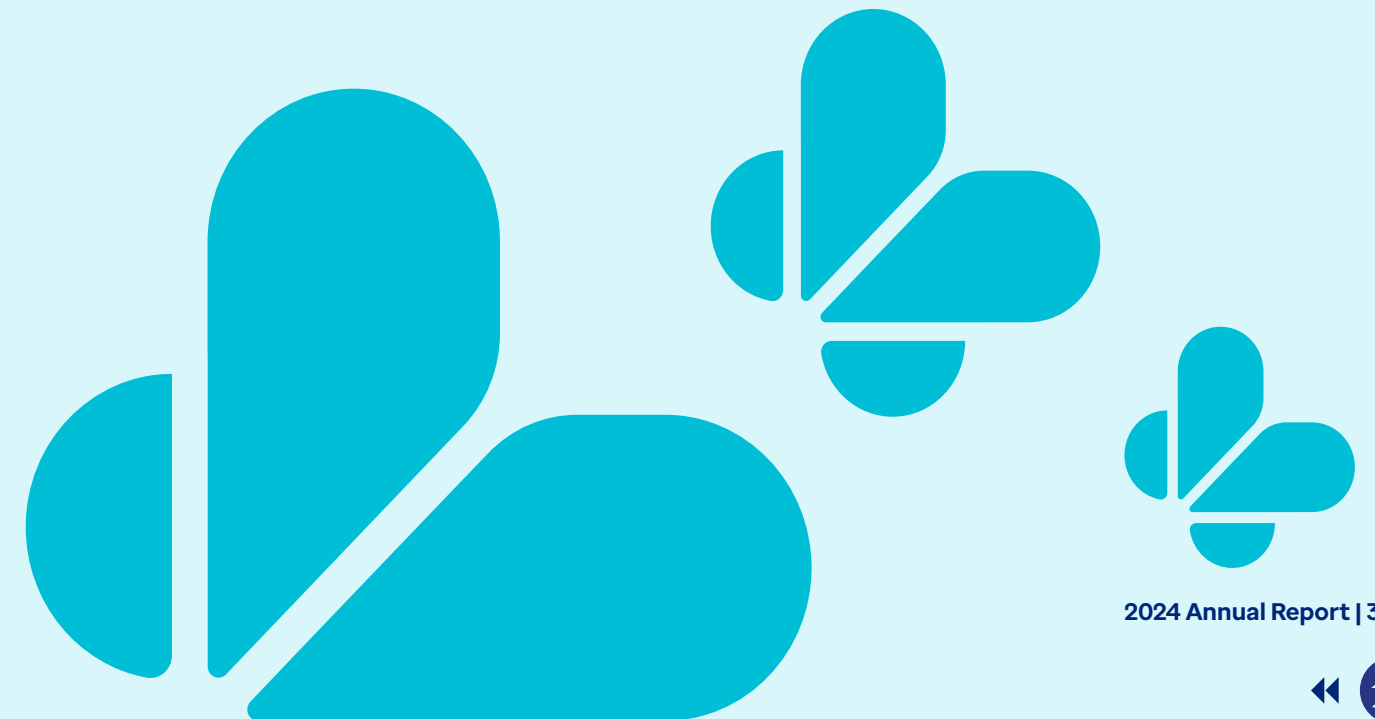

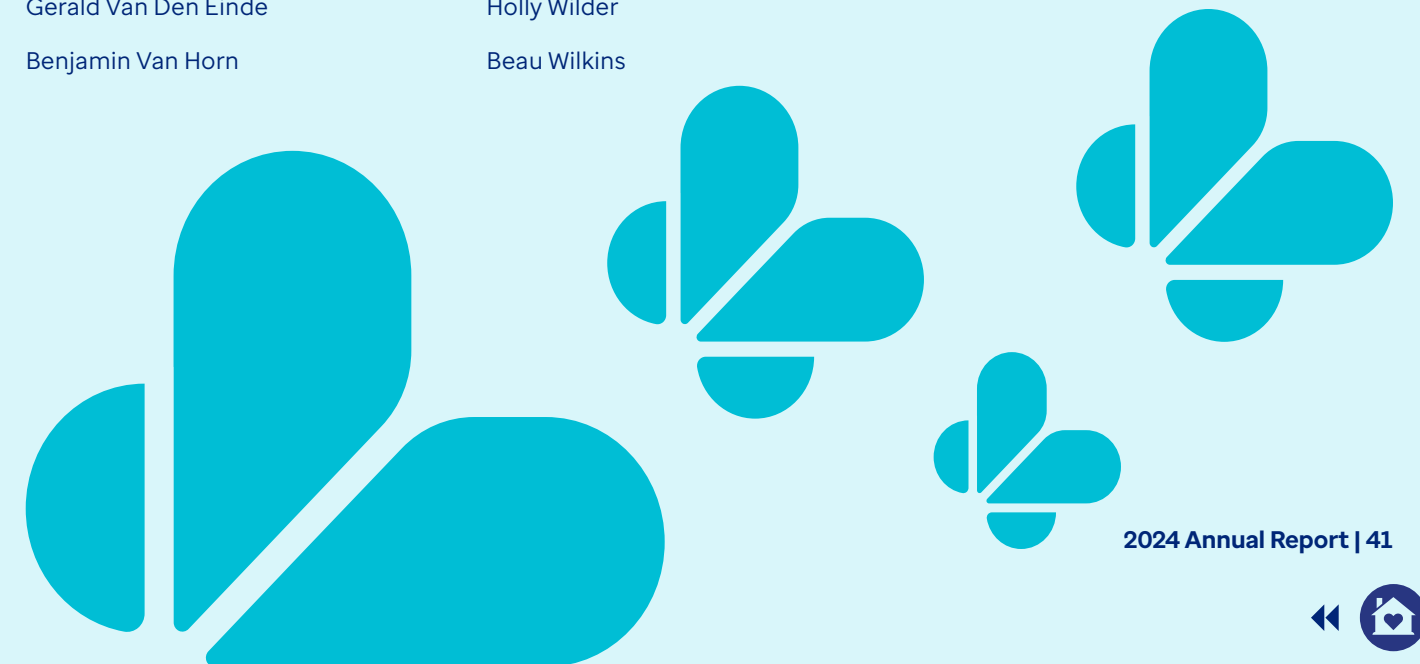
