UnitedHealthcare Children's Foundation (UHCCF) is a 501(c)(3) charitable organization that provides medical grants to help children across the United States access health-related services not covered, or not fully covered, by their family's commercial health insurance. Applicants do not need to be members of UnitedHealthcare to apply. Supported by individuals, corporations and UnitedHealth Group employees, UHCCF is helping kids and changing lives.

Grants cover a variety of medical expenses*

UHCCF grants can help families pay for medical care, treatments, and equipment for their children. Eligible expenses may include hospital stays, surgeries, cancer treatment, prescription medications, wheelchairs, orthotics, hearing aids, eyeglasses, diabetes-related supplies, therapy services, and other medically necessary care.

Important reminder: A UHCCF medical grant may cover eligible expenses incurred up to 90 days before a grant application is deemed complete, and for up to one year after the grant is approved.

UHCCF medical grants help families focus on what matters most – improving the quality of life of their child.

See if your child is eligible:

- 1 Child must be 16 years of age or younger at the time of application, living in the United States and facing a clinical condition.
- 2 Child must be covered by a commercial health insurance plan. **Note:** Insurance coverage does not have to be through UnitedHealthcare.
- 3 Family must not exceed maximum eligible adjusted gross income as documented on IRS Tax Form 1040.

Family size	Adjusted gross income
2 people	\$65K or less
3 people	\$100K or less
4 people	\$135K or less
5+ people	\$170K or less
