UnitedHealthcare Children's Foundation (UHCCF) offers timely financial support to families, so they can focus on what is most important - improving the quality of life of their child. UHCCF grants help with medical expenses not covered, or not fully covered, by their commercial health insurance.

Examples of medical needs covered by UHCCF grants:

- + \$50 pays for office visit co-pays
- + \$100 pays for insulin supplies
- + \$250 pays for eye exam and glasses
- + \$500 pays for 10 hours of speech therapy
- + \$1,000 pays for 10 physical therapy sessions

Families are not required to have UnitedHealthcare insurance to apply (over 80% of grant recipients do not), but must have commercial health insurance as primary coverage.

UHCCF applications are reviewed and funded by one of four regional boards. These boards meet on a monthly basis.

UHCCF strives to help as many children as possible. Often families simply need assistance to bridge a financial gap. The average grant awarded during 2017 was \$1,812.

The maximum grant award amount is \$5,000 per child (age 16 or younger) with a lifetime maximum per child of \$10,000. UHCCF encourages families to apply according to their current needs and reapply as additional needs arise.
